Father in the name of Jesus Christ, you said in your word that whosoever findeth a wife findeth a good thing and obtaineth favor of the Lord. Father, I am asking you to hear my prayer and according to these words of my mouth, place spiritual favor on my husband. Lord, give him favor in business matters, on his job, with the leaders and with other men.

Father, impart spiritual wisdom and gifts to my husband.

Rom 1:11 For I long to see you, that I may impart unto you some spiritual gift, to the end ye may be established;

Crucify any measure of flesh upon him and cause him to walk after your Spirit. Thank you for meeting all our material needs but Lord these are the weightier matters. These are the things that make my husband eternally for the Kingdom of God and the call of God which is upon his life.

Rom 8:6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

Rom 8:7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

Rom 8:8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

Rom 8:9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

Rom 8:10 And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.

Rom 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

Give my husband the wisdom to compare spiritual things to spiritual things. Give Him the Spirit of God in full measure to know what is in the heart of God for this family, for his job, for his call and the ministry.

1 Co 2:9 But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.

- 1 Co 2:10 But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.
- 1 Co 2:11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.
- 1 Co 2:12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.
- 1 Co 2:13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.
- 1 Co 2:14 But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.
- 1 Co 2:15 But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.
- 1 Co 2:16 For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.

Let my husband drink daily from the Spiritual Rock, which is Jesus Christ. Let him drink until he thirsts no more.

- 1 Co 10:4 And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ.

Enlighten him on all spiritual gifts. Teach him the diversities of operations of his gifts. Make him comfortable flowing in his gifts everywhere he goes. Show him daily that his gifts are not just for the church but also for the world around him.

- 1 Co 12:1 Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I would not have you ignorant.
- 1 Co 12:2 Ye know that ye were Gentiles, carried away unto these dumb idols, even as ye were led.
- 1 Co 12:3 Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost.
- 1 Co 12:4 Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.
- 1 Co 12:5 And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord.
- 1 Co 12:6 And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all.
- 1 Co 12:7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.
- 1 Co 12:8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit;
- 1 Co 12:9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;
- 1 Co 12:10 To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:

- 1 Co 12:11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.
- 1 Co 12:12 For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ.
- 1 Co 12:13 For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit

Father, your word say that if I ask anything in agreement with your will, you would hear me. I ask in the name of Jesus that my husband would desire and covet to prophesy. I pray Lord that you would place and perfect this gift in his life by your Holy Ghost Power. Thank you for tongues but allow my husband to be able to prophesy to this family, to our children, to our extended family, to the church. Give and perfect this gift in the way that it should operate in him.

- 1 Co 14:1 Follow after charity, and desire spiritual gifts, but rather that ye may prophesy.
- 1 Co 14:2 For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries.
- 1 Co 14:3 But he that prophesieth speaketh unto men to edification, and exhortation, and comfort.
- 1 Co 14:4 He that speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself; but he that prophesieth edifieth the church.
- 1 Co 14:5 I would that ye all spake with tongues, but rather that ye prophesied: for greater is he that prophesieth than he that speaketh with tongues, except he interpret, that the church may receive edifying.
- 1 Co 14:6 Now, brethren, if I come unto you speaking with tongues, what shall I profit you, except I shall speak to you either by revelation, or by knowledge, or by prophesying, or by doctrine?
- 1 Co 14:7 And even things without life giving sound, whether pipe or harp, except they give a distinction in the sounds, how shall it be known what is piped or harped?
- 1 Co 14:8 For if the trumpet give an uncertain sound, who shall prepare himself to the battle?
- 1 Co 14:9 So likewise ye, except ye utter by the tongue words easy to be understood, how shall it be known what is spoken? for ye shall speak into the air.
- 1 Co 14:10 There are, it may be, so many kinds of voices in the world, and none of them is without signification.
- 1 Co 14:11 Therefore if I know not the meaning of the voice, I shall be unto him that speaketh a barbarian, and he that speaketh shall be a barbarian unto me.
- 1 Co 14:12 Even so ye, forasmuch as ye are zealous of spiritual gifts, seek that ye may excel to the edifying of the church.
- 1 Co 14:13 Wherefore let him that speaketh in an unknown tongue pray that he may interpret.
- 1 Co 14:14 For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful.
- 1 Co 14:15 What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also.
- 1 Co 14:16 Else when thou shalt bless with the spirit, how shall he that occupieth the room of the unlearned say Amen at thy giving of thanks, seeing he understandeth not what thou sayest?

- 1 Co 14:17 For thou verily givest thanks well, but the other is not edified.
- 1 Co 14:18 I thank my God, I speak with tongues more than ye all:
- 1 Co 14:19 Yet in the church I had rather speak five words with my understanding, that by my voice I might teach others also, than ten thousand words in an unknown tongue.
- 1 Co 14:20 Brethren, be not children in understanding: howbeit in malice be ye children, but in understanding be men.
- 1 Co 14:21 In the law it is written, With men of other tongues and other lips will I speak unto this people; and yet for all that will they not hear me, saith the Lord.
- 1 Co 14:22 Wherefore tongues are for a sign, not to them that believe, but to them that believe not: but prophesying serveth not for them that believe not, but for them which believe.
- 1 Co 14:23 If therefore the whole church be come together into one place, and all speak with tongues, and there come in those that are unlearned, or unbelievers, will they not say that ye are mad?
- 1 Co 14:24 But if all prophesy, and there come in one that believeth not, or one unlearned, he is convinced of all, he is judged of all:
- 1 Co 14:25 And thus are the secrets of his heart made manifest; and so falling down on his face he will worship God, and report that God is in you of a truth.
- 1 Co 14:26 How is it then, brethren? when ye come together, every one of you hath a psalm, hath a doctrine, hath a tongue, hath a revelation, hath an interpretation. Let all things be done unto edifying.
- 1 Co 14:27 If any man speak in an unknown tongue, let it be by two, or at the most by three, and that by course; and let one interpret.
- 1 Co 14:28 But if there be no interpreter, let him keep silence in the church; and let him speak to himself, and to God.
- 1 Co 14:29 Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge.
- 1 Co 14:30 If any thing be revealed to another that sitteth by, let the first hold his peace.
- 1 Co 14:31 For ye may all prophesy one by one, that all may learn, and all may be comforted.
- 1 Co 14:32 And the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets.
- 1 Co 14:33 For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints.
- 1 Co 14:34 Let your women keep silence in the churches: for it is not permitted unto them to speak; but they are commanded to be under obedience, as also saith the law.
- 1 Co 14:35 And if they will learn any thing, let them ask their husbands at home: for it is a shame for women to speak in the church.
- 1 Co 14:36 What? came the word of God out from you? or came it unto you only?
- 1 Co 14:37 If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the commandments of the Lord.
- 1 Co 14:38 But if any man be ignorant, let him be ignorant.
- 1 Co 14:39 Wherefore, brethren, covet to prophesy, and forbid not to speak with tongues.
- 1 Co 14:40 Let all things be done decently and in order.

You created your man to be glorious in Jesus Christ. Please Lord, bring about the manifestation that would cause the Glory of the Lord Jesus Christ to shine continuously in my husband. If Moses could come near you Lord and his entire face glowed, how much more oh God should the Glory of the Lord Jesus Christ resinate from his life.

Bring out your Glory all over him. Let his countenance be made by your glory. Don't let him look and feel weary and tired and beaten. Let the strength and glory of the Lord Jesus Christ rest upon him and work life to him.

- Eph 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:
- Eph 1:4 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:
- Eph 1:5 Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,
- Eph 1:6 To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.
- Eph 1:7 In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;
- Eph 1:8 Wherein he hath abounded toward us in all wisdom and prudence;
- Eph 1:9 Having made known unto us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself:
- Eph 1:10 That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him:
- Eph 1:11 In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:
- Eph 1:12 That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ.

Teach my husband to speak the word of God to himself and to hear what he speaks. Faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the Word of God. Every time his mouth sings a song, let his spirit man be edified and faith be built in him. Every time his mouth uttered a scripture let his spirit man leap inside of him.

- Eph 5:19 Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord;
- Eph 5:20 Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;
- Eph 5:21 Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.

Father I ask you to perfect and intensify his warfare. Cause him not to put up with Satan and his tricks. Cause him to put on his whole armour daily. Lord I pray it over him that even as I pray Father that you dress him in the armour by your Spirit.

- Eph 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Eph 6:13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.
- Eph 6:14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;
- Eph 6:15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;
- Eph 6:16 Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.
- Eph 6:17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:
- Eph 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;
- Eph 6:19 And for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel,
- Eph 6:20 For which I am an ambassador in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

Father Paul asked for 12 things in these few verses of scriptures for the Colossians. I ask for all 12 for my husband.

- Col 1:9 For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;
- Col 1:10 That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God;
- Col 1:11 Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness;

- 1. Fill him with the knowledge of Your will in every area of his life!!!***
- 2. Fill with him will all wisdom***
- 3. Give him spiritual understanding***
- 4. Cause him to walk worthy of You***
- 5. Cause him to walk pleasing to You***
- 6. Cause him to be fruitful in all good works***
- 7. Increase him in the knowledge of You***

8. *Strengthen him with all might*
9. *Give to him Your Glorious Power*
10. *Give him all patience*
11. *Cause him to be longsuffering*
12. *Let him have joy*

Build my husband Oh Lord into a spiritual house just like Jesus Christ our Lord. Let him be a righteous, diligent and faithful holy priest over this home. Let him be a righteous priest over the church and other men in the church.

- 1 Pe 2:5 Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ.
- 1 Pe 2:6 Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Sion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believeth on him shall not be confounded.
- 1 Pe 2:7 Unto you therefore which believe he is precious: but unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner,
- 1 Pe 2:8 And a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, even to them which stumble at the word, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed.
- 1 Pe 2:9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should show forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

FATHER IN THE NAME OF JESUS CHRIST, I ASK YOU FOR ABUNDANT, OVERFLOWING FAVOR FOR MY HUSBAND. LORD YOUR WORD IS FULL OF MEN OF GOD WHO GREW IN GRACE AND FAVOR WITH BOTH GOD AND MAN. AS I PRAY EVERY ONE OF THESE SCRIPTURES OH LORD, POUR OUT YOUR NEVER ENDING FAVOR ON MY HUSBAND LORD.

HE NEEDS FAVOR IN EVERY AREA OF YOUR LIFE TO FULFILL YOUR WILL. I BELIEVE WITH ALL OF MY HEART THAT YOU ARE NOT A RESPECTER OF PERSONS!!!! I CONFESS THAT YOU ARE NOT A RESPECTER OF PERSONS, IF YOU WILL GIVE FAVOR TO JOSEPH, SAMUEL AND NEHEMIAH, YOU WILL SURELY GIVE IT TO MY HUSBAND WHO IS ALSO YOUR SON!!!

ARISE MY GOD AND DEMONSTRATE YOUR POWER AND GIFT OF GRACE IN HIS LIFE. SHOW HIM THE ABUNDANCE OF YOUR FAVOR, LOVE AND APPROVAL BECAUSE OF YOUR SON JESUS CHRIST. BECAUSE OF THE BLOOD, I ASK YOU TO DEMONSTRATE YOUR DIVINE FAVOR IN MY HUSBANDS LIFE.

- Ge 39:6 And he left all that he had in Joseph's hand; and he knew not ought he had, save the bread which he did eat. And Joseph was a goodly person, and well favoured.

- Ge 39:21 But the LORD was with Joseph, and showed him mercy, and gave him favour in the sight of the keeper of the prison.
- Ge 39:22 And the keeper of the prison committed to Joseph's hand all the prisoners that were in the prison; and whatsoever they did there, he was the doer of it.
- Ge 39:23 The keeper of the prison looked not to any thing that was under his hand; because the LORD was with him, and that which he did, the LORD made it to prosper.
- Ex 3:21 And I will give this people favour in the sight of the Egyptians: and it shall come to pass, that, when ye go, ye shall not go empty:
- Ex 3:22 But every woman shall borrow of her neighbour, and of her that sojourneth in her house, jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment: and ye shall put them upon your sons, and upon your daughters; and ye shall spoil the Egyptians.
- Ex 11:3 And the LORD gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians. Moreover the man Moses was very great in the land of Egypt, in the sight of Pharaoh's servants, and in the sight of the people.
- Ex 12:36 And the LORD gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they lent unto them such things as they required. And they spoiled the Egyptians
- 1sa 2:26 And the child Samuel grew on, and was in favour both with the LORD, and also with men.
- Job 10:12 Thou hast granted me life and favour, and thy visitation hath preserved my spirit

- Job 33:25 His flesh shall be fresher than a child's: he shall return to the days of his youth:
- Job 33:26 He shall pray unto God, and he will be favourable unto him: and he shall see his face with joy: for he will render unto man his righteousness.

- Ps 90:15 Make us glad according to the days wherein thou hast afflicted us, and the years wherein we have seen evil.
- Ps 90:16 Let thy work appear unto thy servants, and thy glory unto their children.
- Ps 90:17 And let the beauty of the LORD our God be upon us: and establish thou the work of our hands upon us; yea, the work of our hands establish thou it.
- Ps 5:12 For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield.

NO MORE SHALL HE TAKE ANY JUNK OFF SATAN AND HIS DEMONS.

- Ps 41:11 By this I know that thou favourest me, because mine enemy doth not triumph over me.
- Ps 41:12 And as for me, thou upholdest me in mine integrity, and settest me before thy face for ever.
- Ps 41:13 Blessed be the LORD God of Israel from everlasting, and to everlasting. Amen, and Amen.
- Ps 44:3 For they got not the land in possession by their own sword, neither did their own arm save them: but thy right hand, and thine arm, and the light of thy countenance, because thou hadst a favour unto them.
- Ps 89:17 For thou art the glory of their strength: and in thy favour our horn shall be exalted.
- Ps 89:18 For the LORD is our defence; and the Holy One of Israel is our king.
- Ps 102:13 Thou shalt arise, and have mercy upon Zion: for the time to favour her, yea, the set time, is come.
- Ps 102:14 For thy servants take pleasure in her stones, and favour the dust thereof.
- Ps 102:15 So the heathen shall fear the name of the LORD, and all the kings of the earth thy glory.
- Ps 102:16 When the LORD shall build up Zion, he shall appear in his glory.

Ps 112:5 A good man showeth favour, and lendeth: he will guide his affairs with discretion.

Ps 112:6 Surely he shall not be moved for ever: the righteous shall be in everlasting remembrance.

Ps 112:7 He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: his heart is fixed, trusting in the LORD.

Ps 112:8 His heart is established, he shall not be afraid, until he see his desire upon his enemies.

Ps 112:9 He hath dispersed, he hath given to the poor; his righteousness endureth for ever; his horn shall be exalted with honour.

Pro 3:1 My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments:

Pro 3:2 For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee.

Pro 3:3 Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart:

Pro 3:4 So shalt thou find favour and good understanding in the sight of God and man.

Pro 3:5 Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

Pro 3:6 In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

Pro 3:7 Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil.

Pro 3:8 It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones.

Pro 3:9 Honour the LORD with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase:

Pro 3:10 So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.

Pro 3:11 My son, despise not the chastening of the LORD; neither be weary of his correction:

Pro 3:12 For whom the LORD loveth he correcteth; even as a father the son in whom he delighteth.

Pro 3:13 Happy is the man that findeth wisdom, and the man that getteth understanding.

Pro 8:33 Hear instruction, and be wise, and refuse it not.

Pro 8:34 Blessed is the man that heareth me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors.

Pro 8:35 For whoso findeth me findeth life, and shall obtain favour of the LORD

Pro 11:27 He that diligently seeketh good procureth favour: but he that seeketh mischief, it shall come unto him.

Pro 11:28 He that trusteth in his riches shall fall: but the righteous shall flourish as a branch.

Pro 11:29 He that troubleth his own house shall inherit the wind: and the fool shall be servant to the wise of heart.

Pro 11:30 The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life; and he that winneth souls is wise.

Pro 11:31 Behold, the righteous shall be recompensed in the earth: much more the wicked and the sinner.

Pro 16:15 In the light of the king's countenance is life; and his favour is as a cloud of the latter rain.

- Pro 16:16 How much better is it to get wisdom than gold! and to get understanding rather to be chosen than silver!
- Pro 28:23 He that rebuketh a man afterwards shall find more favour than he that flattereth with the tongue.
- Dan 1:9 Now God had brought Daniel into favour and tender love with the prince of the eunuchs.
- Lu 2:52 And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man.
- Ac 2:47 Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.

GIVE HIM DILIGENCE AND STEWARDSHIP OVER OUR HOME AND EVERYTHING THAT YOU SET HIS HANDS TO. WHATEVER HIS HANDS FIND TO DO, LET HIM TO IT TO THE GLORY OF GOD AS A FAITHFUL AND GOOD STEWARD.

- Lu 12:42 And the Lord said, Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom his lord shall make ruler over his household, to give them their portion of meat in due season?
- Lu 12:43 Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing.
- Lu 12:44 Of a truth I say unto you, that he will make him ruler over all that he hath.
- 1 Co 4:1 Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God.
- 1 Co 4:2 Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful.
- Tit 1:7 For a bishop must be blameless, as the steward of God; not selfwilled, not soon angry, not given to wine, no striker, not given to filthy lucre;
- Tit 1:8 But a lover of hospitality, a lover of good men, sober, just, holy, temperate;
- Tit 1:9 Holding fast the faithful word as he hath been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers.
- Tit 1:10 For there are many unruly and vain talkers and deceivers, specially they of the circumcision:
- Tit 1:11 Whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole houses, teaching things which they ought not, for filthy lucre's sake.

GIVE HIM OH GOD, ACCORDING TO YOUR STANDARDS, THE GRACE TO MINISTER LIFE TO OTHER MEN. GIVE HIM FATHER, THE ABILITY TO MINISTER ON THE JOB AND IN THE OTHER MARKET PLACES THE LIFE AND WORK OF THE LORD JESUS CHRIST. LET HIM NOT BE MOVED BY ANY FIERY TRIALS. LET HIM COUNT IT A BLESSING TO SUFFER AS A BELIEVER AND NO LONGER AS AN EVILDOER.

- 1 Pe 4:10 As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.
- 1 Pe 4:11 If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.
- 1 Pe 4:12 Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you:
- 1 Pe 4:13 But rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Christ's sufferings; that, when his glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy.
- 1 Pe 4:14 If ye be reproached for the name of Christ, happy are ye; for the spirit of glory and of God resteth upon you: on their part he is evil spoken of, but on your part he is glorified.
- 1 Pe 4:15 But let none of you suffer as a murderer, or as a thief, or as an evildoer, or as a busybody in other men's matters.
- 1 Pe 4:16 Yet if any man suffer as a Christian, let him not be ashamed; but let him glorify God on this behalf.
- 1 Pe 4:17 For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?
- 1 Pe 4:18 And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear?
- 1 Pe 4:19 Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to him in well doing, as unto a faithful Creator.
